Scripture:
Genesis 1-2

What does this say about God and man?

- God is eternal. (He has no beginning or end)
- God is the Creator and owner of all things.
- God is all-powerful. (He can do anything, nothing is too hard for God)
- God is good; everything God made is good because God is good.
- God created the world and man for his glory.
- God delights in his creation; He is a happy God.
- God is supreme. (God is greater than all creation)
- God communicates with man
- Man needs God

(There was no suitable mate for Adam; Adam could not make a mate for himself; God made him a mate.)

QUESTIONS AND RESPONSES: Below are questions and responses to help you and your child interact with the scripture passage, and to solicit a personal response from both of you to the truths of the Bible story. Please allow the Holy Spirit to guide you to further questions and responses.

- * How could God make things out of nothing, by just speaking? Can anyone you know do that?
- * Where does life come from? Where does **everything** come from? Who gives life to man and everything else? Can we make ourselves alive? (Only God can make things alive)
- * Everything God made has a beginning—Does God? (God has **always** been; there has never been a time without God)
